Hong Kong's OFC grant scheme – not quite last call but close



Fund managers have a few more months until 9 May 2024 to save costs if they plan to set up or redomicile an open-ended fund company (OFC) in Hong Kong.

The Hong Kong Securities and Futures Commission's (SFC)'s HK\$270 million grant scheme for OFCs and real estate investment trusts (REITs) (Grant Scheme) covers expenses paid to Hong Kong-based service providers, such as legal advisers, auditors, accounts or tax advisors, fund administrators, or regulatory consultants, for work tied to the incorporation or redomiciliation of OFCs. The grant is allocated on a first-come-first-served basis to OFCs incorporated in Hong Kong, and non-Hong Kong fund corporations that redomiciled as OFCs on or after 10 May 2021.
